

Town Board Meeting June 3, 2009

James Parent called a special Town Board meeting to order at 6:45PM in the meeting room at the Town Hall. Present were James Parent, Robert Schultz, Barbara Anschutz, Dale Williams, Douglas Smith and 2 visitors. Peter Jacobs was absent.

Clerk verified posting. Motion made/second Dale/Barb to accept the agenda. Carried.

Discuss/decide sidewalk project by Emmanuel Lutheran Church – They would like to have sidewalk curb-to-curb, so it would be a little wider. Wheelchair accessible needs to be 5 feet. Mark Franke drew up a quote. The light load charges could be taken out. Mike LeClair was present and explained what they would like to do. The crews doing the other roadwork in town are going to be replacing some ramps down in that area, so we need to figure out what we're doing before they start the process. There is a handicap parking spot on the south side already with a ramp. In front of the lift station, there is a crosswalk right now that will be removed. There is not one across the street in front of the parish hall. The labor for the process is probably about 80 to 90 hours. It may actually be a better idea to have the ramps on the north and south sides rather than the one in the middle. If curbing has to get ripped out, we have to know by tomorrow. The north one may have to be ripped out. Since the crews are here, we should have them do the ramps. The portion that needs to be ripped out will be donated by various entities. It will be physically looked at before work begins to determine the best places for the ramps, etc. Mike was guessing the total for concrete and labor would be \$6,600. The church would pay at least \$3,000. Motion made/second Dale/Barb to approve the sidewalk and curbing work in front of the Lutheran Church, not to exceed \$5,000. Carried.

Motion made/second Dale/Barb to adjourn at 7:12PM. Carried.
