

## Town Board Road Check April 23, 2011

Donald Sitte called a special meeting of the Baileys Harbor Town Board to order at 7:30AM in the parking lot of the Town Hall. Present were Donald Sitte, Peter Jacobs, Barbara Anschutz, Robert Schultz, Roberta Thelen, Douglas Smith and Steven Parent.

Clerk verified posting. Motion made/second Bob/Barb to accept the agenda. Carried.

The Town Board left immediately to begin the Road Check. Items of note:

- The new section of Frogtown Road is cracked all along the new blacktop.
- The Board walked along the beach below Frogtown. Some funding (up to \$40,000) has opened up for the Army Corps. to do a study on the situation. Steve will give them the go ahead to begin the study. As for the actual repairs, there is potentially an 80/20 grant available.
- The Board walked Chapel Lane and discussed potential upgrades. Bob was thinking approximately 18 feet of blacktop, which would mean some trees would need to be cut. Any trees cut would be replaced at the Town's expense. Power poles would need to be moved. Frontier should also be contacted in regards to burying their phone lines. A turnaround of some sort, such as a cul-de-sac was discussed for the end of the road at Bjorklunden's property. Steve will have a plan created and all property owners along the road will have a chance for input prior to anything being given the green light.
- Harvest Moon needs a "private drive" sign
- The Kangaroo Lake boat launch needs some work, as the dock is bent and there's a pretty large dropoff. Steve will look into permits for filling it in as well as a quit-claim deed for some property that's in question.
- The ice pushed the cement up at Kangaroo Beach, but we'll see about moving it back in with a bulldozer and then have the maintenance staff patch it up. Steve will also have the property surveyed. A dog waste bag dispenser will also be installed
- Kangaroo Beach Road is in bad condition
- The Board looked at the easement from the end of Deer Crest Court south to Highway 57. It would be a very nice area for a walking/bike path. This should be put into the bike plan, if it isn't already.
- Anclam Road needs work.
- Cana Cove Road area should be surveyed.
- East and West Ridgeview will be re-done

Motion made/second Bob/Barb to adjourn at 10:25AM. Carried.
