

ORDINANCE NO. 2-2003
COLLECTION OF SEWER CHARGE ARREARAGES

Purpose

This ordinance is entitled "Collection of Sewer Charge Arreages". The purpose of this ordinance is to set guidelines for the imposition of penalties on outstanding sewer charges.


Authority

The Town Board of the Town of Baileys Harbor has the specific statutory authority, powers and duties, pursuant to the specific statutory sections noted in this ordinance and/or by it's adoption of village powers under Section 60.10, 95-96 Wisconsin State Statutes, to regulate, control, prevent and enforce against, in the Town of Baileys Harbor, certain uses, activities, businesses and operations by persons that may affect the public works and infrastructure in the town.

NOW THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE TOWN BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE TOWN OF BAILEYS HARBOR, DOOR COUNTY, WISCONSIN as follows:


1. A commercial wastewater hauler's bill is expected to be paid in full within 30 days of the statement date. On the 31st day a 1-1/2% penalty shall be added to the outstanding amount on the bill. On the 61st day an additional 5% penalty shall be added to the outstanding amount of the bill. Starting on the 91st day, the hauler will not be allowed to dump wastewater obtained from properties outside of the township at the Baileys Harbor Treatment Plant until all outstanding bills are paid in full. The town administrative office shall immediately report all delinquent accounts to the Plant Manager.
2. Pumpers considered delinquent would still be allowed to dump wastewater obtained from properties within the township.
3. This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as required by law.
