

**Town of Baileys Harbor  
Resolution 03-01  
Requesting Reform of NWTC Practices  
And Funding Policies**

WHEREAS the Town of Baileys Harbor is assessed a portion of the funds needed to operate the Northeast Wisconsin Technical College (NWTC), and

WHEREAS Door County as a whole voted "NO" in a 2001 referendum addressing increased funding levels, and

WHEREAS in proportion to the dollars contributed to the regional NWTC system, the residents of the Town of Baileys Harbor receive acutely limited service from the campus based in Sturgeon Bay, and

WHEREAS the appointed Board of the NWTC system is not accountable or responsive to the needs of Baileys Harbor residents, and

WHEREAS the technical education system recently designated that it no longer be known as a technical "institute" but had in practice and effect, achieved the status of a technical "college" in the State of Wisconsin:

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Town of Baileys Harbor requests that the Wisconsin Legislature review the current operational, decision making and taxing authority of the Technical College system in Wisconsin, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Town of Baileys Harbor recommends that as a College system operating in the State of Wisconsin, that the Technical Colleges should be operated as all other state-supported colleges, both in oversight and funding, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Town Board of the Town of Baileys Harbor requests that the Town Clerk send copies of this Resolution to the Wisconsin Towns Association, Senator Alan Lasee, Rep. Garey Bies, appropriate legislative committees, and local Municipal Clerks.
