

TOWN OF BAILEYS HARBOR
CAMPING ORDINANCE
87-1

THE TOWN BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE TOWN OF BAILEYS HARBOR,
COUNTY OF DOOR, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1 - Camping in the Town of Baileys Harbor

It shall be unlawful for any person to camp overnight in any town park or on any piece of town property without written permission from the Town Board of Supervisors of the Town of Baileys Harbor.

SECTION 2 - ENFORCEMENT

It shall be the duty of the Door County Sheriff and the Town of Baileys Harbor Constable to see that the provisions of this ordinance are enforced.

SECTION 3 - PENALTY

Any person violating this ordinance shall forfeit \$25.00 for each offense, plus costs and disbursements. In default of payment of the above forfeiture plus costs and disbursements, the person convicted shall be confined to the county jail until such forfeiture plus costs and disbursements have been paid, not to exceed thirty (30) days.

SECTION 4 - CONFLICTING ORDINANCE

All ordinances in whole or in part which conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5 - VALIDITY

Should any section, clause or provision of this ordinance be declared by the courts to be invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any part thereof, other than the part so declared to be invalid.

SECTION 6 - EFFECTIVE DATE

The foregoing ordinance shall be deemed to be in force from and after its passage, approval, posting, publication and recording, according to law.
