

TOWN OF BAILEYS HARBOR
ORDINANCE 87-2
RESTRICTING HOURS FOR USE OF TOWN PARKS

WHEREAS, the Town of Baileys Harbor has several parks, owned and maintained by the town,

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of public welfare and safety; protection of the public property; and general public good to restrict the use of said parks to reasonable hours,

NOW THEREFORE, the Town of Supervisors of the Town of Baileys Harbor, Door County, does ordain as follows:

SECTION 1 - RESTRICTION OF HOURS

No person may enter, use, or remain on any town park or piece of town property in the Town of Baileys Harbor between the hours of 10:00p.m. and 6:00 a.m., for any purpose, without the written permission of the Town Board of Supervisors of the Town of Baileys Harbor.

SECTION 2 - ENFORCEMENT

It shall be the duty of the Door County Sheriff and the Baileys Harbor Town Constable to see that the provisions of this ordinance are enforced.

SECTION 3 - PENALTY

Any person violating this ordinance shall forfeit \$25.00 for each offence, plus costs and disbursements. In default of payment of the above forfeiture plus costs and disbursements, the person convicted shall be confined to the county jail until such forfeiture plus costs and disbursements have been paid, not to exceed thirty (30) days.

SECTION 4 - SEVERABILITY AND CONFLICT

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or work of this ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court or competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct, independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.

SECTION 5 - EFFECTIVE DATE

The foregoing ordinance shall be deemed to be in force from and after its passage, approval, posting, publication and recording, according to law.
